To: The Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland.

Re: Non Consent Letter of the People of the State of Queensland draws to the attention of the House:

NOTICE of NON-CONSENT to the FLUORIDATION OF MY WATER SUPPLY

NOTICE of NON-CONSENT to ADDING RECYCLED SEWAGE or WASTE WATER to MY WATER SUPPLY

As a State of Queensland water customer, **I DO NOT AUTHORISE, NEITHER DO I CONSENT to the water supplier commencing** to add any FLUORIDE CHEMICAL or COMPOUND and or RECYCLED SEWAGE OR RECYCLED WASTE WATER to the water supply piped into my home.

The fluoride which the water supplier has proposed to add is for the purpose of delivering the chemical into consumers' bodies as a health treatment to give an alleged health benefit. The ethics of medicine and health care dictate that the "informed consent" of the subject must be obtained before commencing any treatment, preventive or otherwise. This letter is my notice that I have independently informed myself. **I choose to withhold my consent to treat my family and myself with fluoride.**

As I have also informed myself of the health hazards and risks coming from the contamination of water as a result of adding recycled sewage to domestic water, **I DO NOT CONSENT to the State of Queensland or any other water supplier** putting my health at risk in this way. **NEITHER DO I CONSENT TO THEM MAKING THIS DECISION regarding my water.**

There is overwhelming scientific evidence and case history reports, which clearly demonstrate, that fluoridating water with sodium fluoride (toxic industrial waste) and or recycled sewage and or industrial waste, causes major and costly health problems. These problems include, brittle bones, thyroid dysfunction, nervous system impairment, dental and skeletal fluorosis, genital deformities in males, feminising of boys, testicular cancer spontaneous abortions, birth defects, kidney failure, hormone disruption, chemical sensitivities and cancer.

I have never authorized the State of Queensland or any other water supplier to act as my health care practitioner or prescriber. The State of Queensland or any other water supplier should have no involvement with forcing mass medication or debilitating carcinogenic substances upon my family or myself.

You have a total of thirty (30) days after the receipt of this Notice, to respond. If you choose not to respond within that period of time, it shall legally be deemed that you accept the terms and conditions of this Notice, and thus will not proceed with the fluoridation and the adding of the recycled sewage and wastewater to my water supply.
